Boyle joined PNC through its acquisition of National City Corporation in December 2008. Prior to his current appointment, Boyle headed National City's northeast Ohio region banking operation. He joined National City with the acquisition of Wayne Bancorp, Inc. in 2004 and subsequently led the markets previously served by Wayne, as well as Stark County. He began his career in 1986 as a certified public accountant in Pittsburgh. In 1990 he joined Wayne Bancorp as their chief financial officer. He was named president and chief executive officer of Wayne Bancorp in 2000 and became chairman in 2003.
